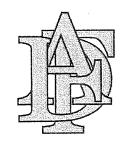

Foreign Fire Tax Insurance Board Meeting Minutes January 19, 2021 (08:30am)

Call to order

FF/PM Gerlich called to order the regular meeting of the Foreign Fire Tax Insurance Board at 08:42 on January 19, 2022.

Roll call
