Foreign Fire Tax Insurance Board Meeting Minutes August 16, 2023 (08:30am)

Call to order

Lt Smith called to order the regular meeting of the Foreign Fire Tax Insurance Board at 08:36 on April 20, 2022.

Roll call

- e) FF/PM Gerlich requested the FFTIB to purchase 6 Refrigerators with ice makers for station71 and 73 to replace broken ones at St. 71 & 73. \$6k total was requested. BC Baxa made a motion and Lt. Smith approved. All were in favor. None opposed.
